

# O Jerusalem -- Postscript

Kudos to the Tacoma Sister Cities and the Blue Mouse for this film festival. And kudos to the Kiryat-Motzkin Committee for selecting this film, as it may serve as a vehicle to begin a discussion locally of the issues presented in the film.

The film 'O Jerusalem' is based on a book written in 1972. In the 1980s, Israeli documents were declassified that give us more, and in some cases different, information about the events depicted in the film as well as other events leading up to the establishment of Israel.

Because "reconciliation and peace must stand on a bedrock of truth," <sup>[1]</sup> we hope you will look through some of the now-declassified history brought to us by the Israeli "new historians" and others.

- It was not just the Jewish terrorist organizations, like the Irgun depicted in the film, that participated in massacres of non-Jews in Palestine. In 1947, David Ben-Gurion and the Haganah, featured prominently in the film, worked out Plan Dalet, that a number of historians say was intended "to expel as many Palestinians as possible." <sup>[2]</sup>
- "We must expel Arabs and take their places." David Ben-Gurion <sup>[3]</sup>
- "Let us not ignore the truth... we are the aggressors and they defend themselves... The country is theirs, because they inhabit it, whereas we want to come here and settle down, and in their view we want to take away their country." David Ben-Gurion <sup>[4]</sup>
- "400,000 [Arabs] were chased out and expelled during the first stage of the war... before the Arab armies invaded the country." Tom Segev, Israeli historian <sup>[5]</sup>
- In all, an estimated 700,000 to 800,000 non-Jewish residents of Palestine were expelled, or fled the massacres and violence. <sup>[6]</sup> Israeli historian Benny Morris expressed regret that Israel did not completely expel Palestine of its Arab majority in 1948. <sup>[16]</sup>
- An estimated 500 Palestinian villages were completely destroyed and erased from the map. <http://www.zochrot.org/index.php?id=341>

Israel's dispossession of Palestinian land and human rights continues to this day.

- Israel has been destroying water cisterns that are the only source of water for some Palestinians. <sup>[7]</sup> Last year, Israel destroyed at least 27 cisterns... <sup>[8]</sup> (See Youtube of Israeli soldiers demolishing cisterns: <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5CpvE9IFlyU>)
- Israel has moved more than 500,000 Jews into new and illegal (per UN) settlements in the Occupied Palestinian Territories (OPT) since 1967; meanwhile, more than 24,000 Palestinian homes in the OPT have been destroyed since 1967. <sup>[9] [10] [11] [12]</sup>
- And within Israel, non-Jews are being expelled to make way for a Jewish park! <sup>[13]</sup>
- The extraordinarily circuitous route of Israel's illegal separation wall is, among other things, taking precious Palestinian water and land. The wall is deemed illegal by the UN International Court of Justice, because it's built almost entirely on Palestinian land, NOT on the pre-1967 border. <sup>[17]</sup>
